Eligibility

We welcome applications from anyone who is currently studying towards/or has completed a minimum of a Master 1 Degree. Students who have completed their studies are also encouraged to apply, including those with professional experience. All applicants must possess a professional level of English in both oral and written.

How to Apply

Applicants meeting our eligibility requirements are invited to submit the following documentation:

- CV
- Copies of diploma and grades
- Copy of Passport or ID card
- One to two references (2 preferred) from non-family members who have known them for a period of at least one year and can attest to their good character
- Any other supporting documents you deem relevant

Documentation must be submitted to legalcareers@maples.com referencing Luxembourg Legal Internship Programme. Applications are accepted year round. The minimum period of our Legal Internship is 4 months.

The selection process involves an interview with two of our partners at the Luxembourg office. If you are unable to attend the interview in person, we can arrange an interview by videoconference. The Maples Group will seek references from the referees named in the application, at their discretion.

Maples Group representatives will attend a number of university career fairs throughout the year to provide more details on our Legal Internship Programme.
